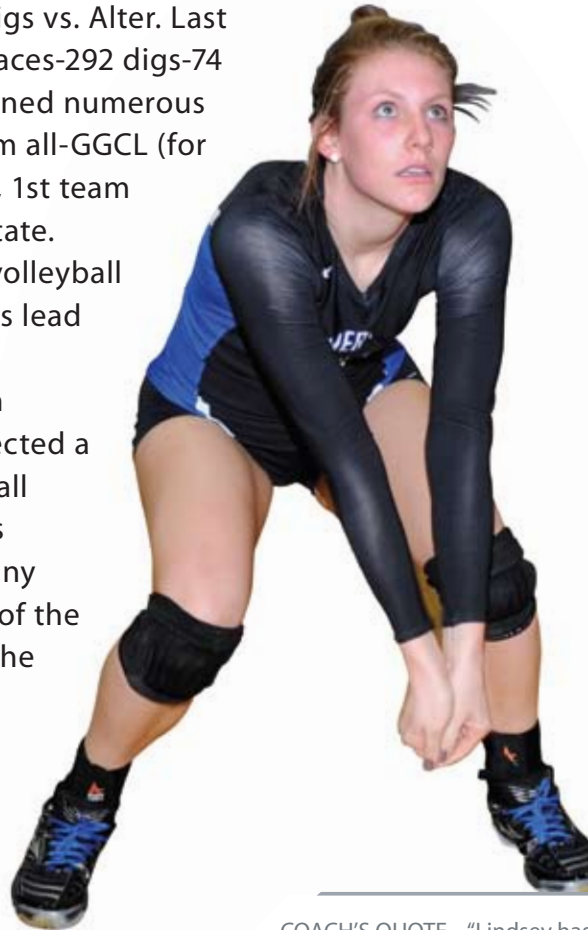


Lindsey Dinkelacker
