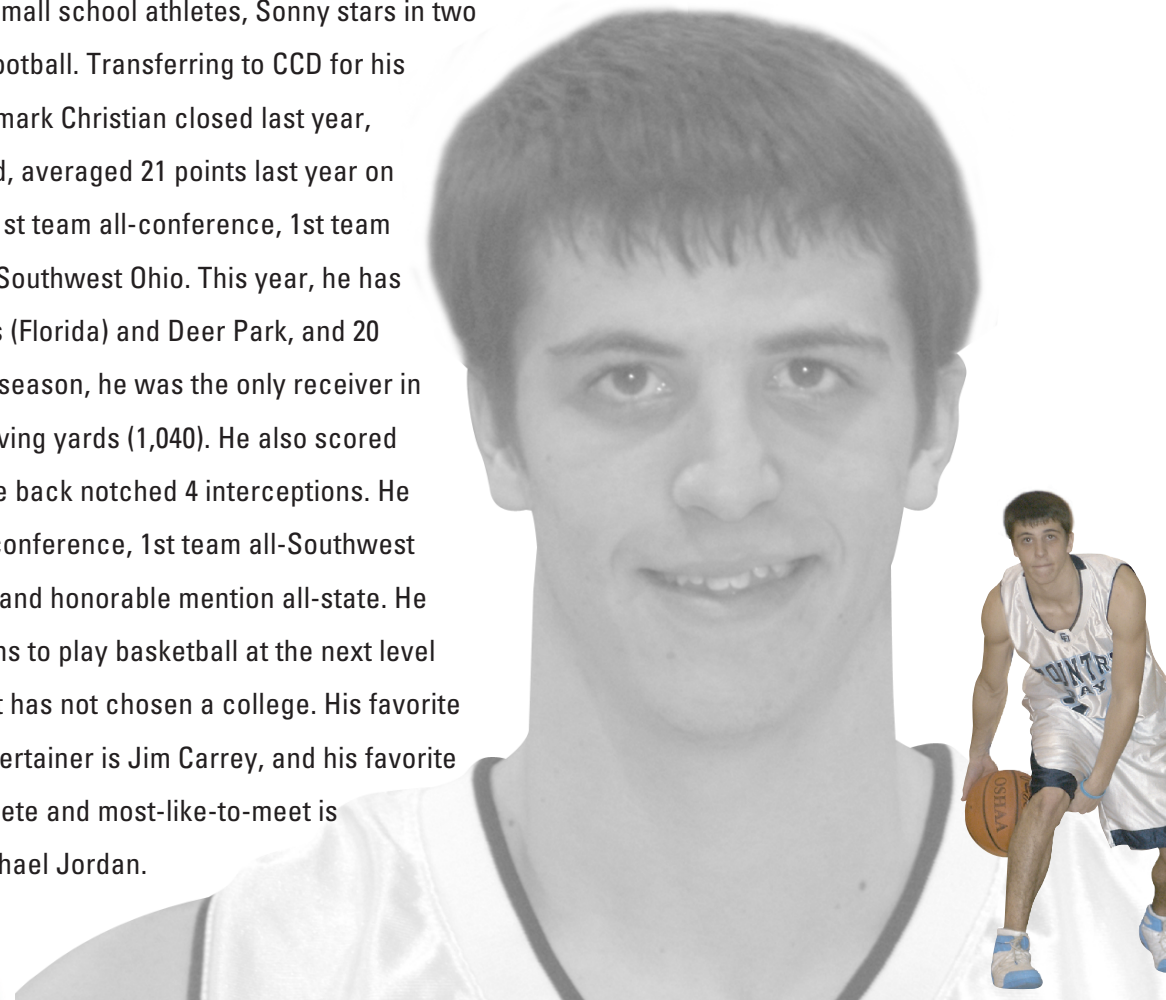
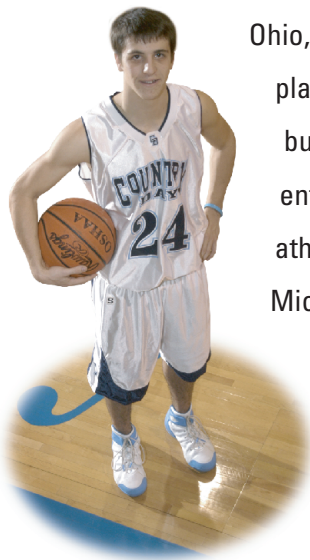


Sonny Snell

One of Cincinnati's best small school athletes, Sonny stars in two sports – basketball and football. Transferring to CCD for his senior season after Landmark Christian closed last year, Sonny, a basketball guard, averaged 21 points last year on the way to being named 1st team all-conference, 1st team all-city, and 3rd team all-Southwest Ohio. This year, he has scored 24 vs. St. Edwards (Florida) and Deer Park, and 20 vs. CHCA. In football this season, he was the only receiver in Ohio to have 1,000+ receiving yards (1,040). He also scored 14 TDs and as a defensive back notched 4 interceptions. He was named 1st team all-conference, 1st team all-Southwest

Ohio, and honorable mention all-state. He plans to play basketball at the next level but has not chosen a college. His favorite entertainer is Jim Carrey, and his favorite athlete and most-like-to-meet is Michael Jordan.
