

Kyle during the regular season had 37 receptions for 623 yards and 11 touchdowns for the 7-4 Panthers. He was named 1st team all-league, 1st team all-city, 1st team SWO district and 2nd team all-Ohio. Kyle was also selected to play in the U.S. Army All-American Bowl in San Antonio, Texas.
