Her junior year, at last year's Kentucky state meet, Emma took third place in the 100 freestyle and sixth place in the 50 freestyle. She earned numerous honors for her accomplishments. II Most Outstanding Swimmer, first-team all-Northern Kentucky (Enquirer) and was named to the Northern Kentucky all-region team for the second straight time.
