Elder senior Luke Vaughn is an all-star baseball player who can play catcher or infield. He is having a good senior season; in 26 games he is batting .426 (fourth in the GCL South) with 24 RBI (fourth in the GCL South) He has had numerous big games, including vs. Loveland when he went 3-4 with four RBI and two runs scored. In a win vs. Western Brown, he went 2-2 with four RBI. In a win vs. St. Xavier, he went 3-4 with two RBI and four runs scored. And, in a win vs. Harrison, he went 3-4 with two RBI.

Luke is coming off a good junior campaign when he hit .360 with five doubles and three triples. He led the league in RBI with 34, plus scored 20 runs and had five stolen bases. For his accomplishments, Luke was named GCL South Player of the Year, Cincinnati Div. I Co-Player of the Year, SWO District Co-Player of the Year, first team all-city and honorable mention all-Ohio.

He will continue his fine play on the collegiate level at the University of Alabama.
